

Investera Cookie Policy

A browser cookie is data that is stored on your device to enable websites and mobile applications recollect information related to you. Other technologies, including web storage and identifiers associated with your device, may be used for similar purposes. In this policy (“**Cookie Policy**”), cookies (“**Cookies**”) will be referred to explain the said technologies.

Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect and use information from and about you when you use the software and the services thereon. This Cookie Policy explains more about how we use the Cookies and your related selections thereof.

How We Use Cookies

Investera uses Cookies for several reasons, including but not limited to protecting your data and account on the software, highlighting the popular features, evaluating quantity of visitors to a page, improving our users’ experience, keeping the software secure, and generally providing you with a better experience. The cookies we use generally fall into one of the following categories:

- i. Preferences: to remember your settings and preferences
- ii. Security: to help identify and prevent security risks.
- iii. Performance: to collect information about how you interact with the software.
- iv. Analytics: to help us improve our software.
- v. Advertising: to deliver relevant advertisements and to track the efficiency of our advertising campaigns on the software.

Your Choices

Your browser or device may allow you to block or otherwise limit the use of Cookies. It is worth noting that Cookies are an important part of how the Software works, this means that removing, rejecting, or limiting the use of the Cookies could affect the availability and functionality of our services on the Software.

Browser Cookies

Your browser may provide you with the option to refuse some or all browser Cookies. You may also be able to remove Cookies from your browser.

Mobile Device Identifiers

Your mobile operating system may let you opt-out from having certain device identifiers used for interest-based advertising. You should refer to the instructions provided by your mobile device’s manufacturer; this information is typically available under the settings function of your mobile device.

And of course, if your mobile device offers an uninstall process, you can always stop us from collecting information through the application by uninstalling the software.
